TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

This is to confirm that Mr Dave Marock was appointed by Wasteman Holdings Pty Ltd as an independent consultant to oversee the clean-up of the Health Care Risk Waste (HCRW-Medical Waste) which had been incorrectly disposed of near Welkom and Klerksdorp.

The purpose of Mr Marock's appointment was to report back to the Wasteman Holdings Board.

Work at the four Welkom sites occurred from 28th January 2010 to 3rd November 2010, until closure and sign-off by the Department of Environment Affairs. The Klerksdorp landfill site was inspected and characterised on the 17th and 18th August 2010. The Vierfontein farm sites near Klerksdorp were inspected and characterised on the 26th January 2011.

The remediation of recently buried HCRW at the Klerksdorp site was undertaken between 18th August 2011 and 14th September 2011. The only remaining site is Vierfontein, which will be completed in early 2012.

Mr Marock worked in conjunction with myself, Ritchie Morris, Pr Sci Nat (86/90), Environmental Hydrogeologist, to ensure total compliance in accordance with all the Department of Environment Affairs (DEA) instructions emanating from the various Compliance Notices issued by the DEA. Mr Marock's focus was on Safety and Health compliance and Operational synergies. He assisted with environmental compliance and ensured that the clean-up resulted in the liability for Wasteman Holdings being managed.
